



Trump Leads by Ten with New Florida Voters

November 1, 2020

For Immediate Release:

According to a Listener Group/Political Matrix study of 772 new Florida voters, Donald Trump is leading Joe Biden52.2% to 42.9% with only 4.9% being undecided. The biggest takeaway is with the NPA voters leaning to Trump with 51% as opposed to 40% for Biden. Topline data and cross tabulated data are on the following pages.

METHODOLOGY:

The cross tabs for this study are age, race, gender and party affiliation. The persons sampled were Florida likely voters with a voting score of 100% for the general election cycles. The voters called were those only with landlines and were called using an Interactive Voice Response (IVR) system and were called during the hours of 1PM to 8PM on November 1, 2020. The Margin of Error for this study is +/- 3.5% with a confidence level of 95%. Please see details on the following pages.
